

Post-doc position in International Macro, Monetary Economics or Banking

Ghent University - Department of Financial Economics (Belgium)

The department of Financial Economics at Ghent University has a new position available for a full time post-doc researcher in the fields of international macroeconomics, monetary economics or banking. The position is initially for one year but can be extended.

It is a full-time research position without teaching duties with the aim to publish in academic journals. The position is funded by the Interuniversity Attraction Poles Programme – Belgian Science Policy, an international network of several universities. The researcher will be part of this network and will be integrated in the Monetary/Macro or Banking team of the department.

Candidates should hold a PhD or are about to obtain this degree. Applications should include a cover letter, CV and examples of research work. Two letters of reference should be sent directly by the advisors. Application deadline is 31 March 2008.
